THEATRE ACCESS POLICY

The theatre has 4 designated
spaces for wheelchair or motorised
scooter users. These spaces should
be pre-booked as the theatre
cannot guarantee spaces upon
arrival. Users of the designated
spaces can be accompanied by a
carer whose seat will be adjacent to
it. Only one ticket will need to be
purchased for the designated space
and carers' seat.

Patrons who do not book one
of the designated spaces and are
able to make their own way to
their seats unaided can enter the
auditorium either via the foyer or
one of the side exits whilst leaving
the wheelchair/motorised scooter
in the foyer.

In addition, there are 7 car parking
spaces situated directly outside the
theatre foyer for the use of disabled
patrons. These spaces must be pre-
booked to avoid disappointment
upon arrival. Only available to Blue

Badge holders - badge number
required at time of booking please.

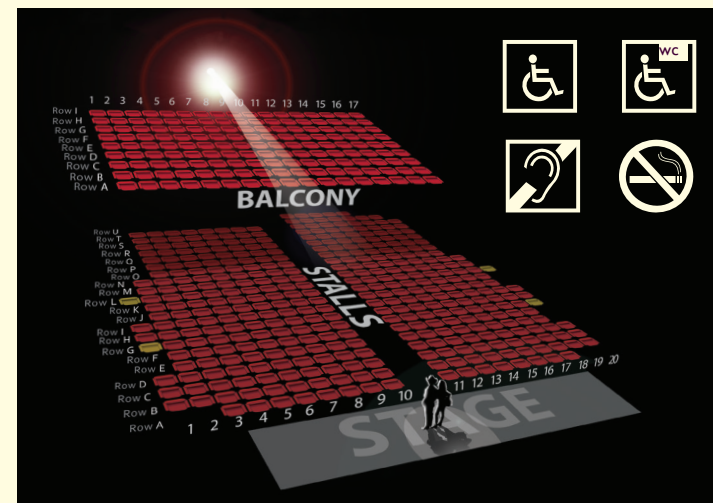

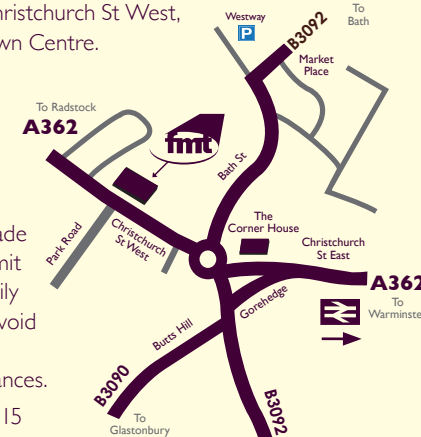
HOW TO FIND US

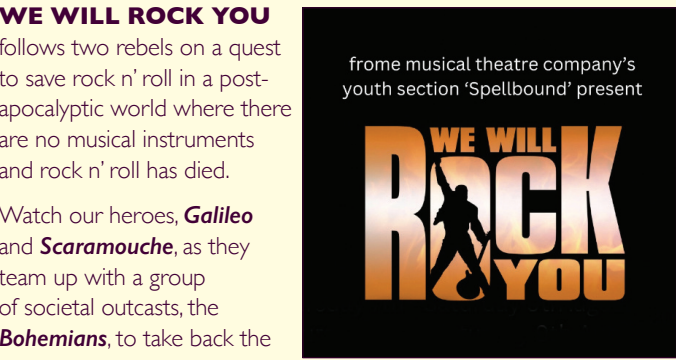

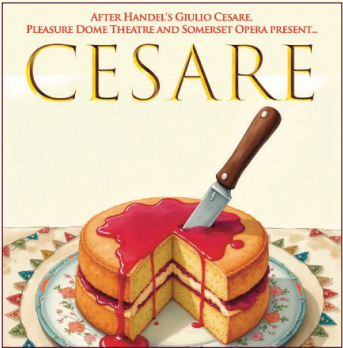
